Announcement of 01 scholarship for students from the Kingdom of Eswatini under the Quad STEM Scholarship Scheme for the Academic Year 2026-27

The High Commission of India, Mbabane announces 01 scholarship for students from the Kingdom of Eswatini under the Quad STEM Scholarship Scheme to pursue a 4 year bachelor's level engineering programme (B.Tech) for the Academic Year 2026-27. The process right from Application to Admission for this scholarship is Online. Following is the schedule for filing applications and acceptance of the same:

27 Feb 2026	Opening of ICCR's A2A Scholarship Portal http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in
15 Apr 2026	Last date for submission of applications on the portal
30 Apr 2026	Last date of universities to inform the decision (if confirmed, intimation to Missions; if rejected, intimation to students)
15 May 2026	Last date of acceptance by students

2. Applications from interested Eswatini students are invited Online through ICCR's A2A Scholarship Portal <http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in>.

Highlights of the Scheme/Admission process (for more information, visit <http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in>)

- The process right from Application to Admission for these scholarships is Online.
- This scholarship cover only undergraduate courses in the field of STEM.
- Applicants should be between 18 and 35 years as on date 01.07.2026.
- It may be noted that for BE/B.Tech courses, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics are compulsory in 11-12 Grades (Form-IV&V) and Mark sheets for Grades 10 to 12 (Form III-V), equivalent level of school should be uploaded along with transcripts.
- Applicants have the option to apply to 5 Universities/Institutes in the order of their preference.
- A 500-word essay in English is mandatory to ascertain English proficiency. Students can also submit their TOFEL/IELTS etc. Standardised Test scores, if available. If desired, Universities will directly conduct interview of applicants online.
- Rejected candidates will be intimated by Universities.
- The scholarships include return economy class airfares.
- Under this scheme applicants may apply at the following institutes;
 - (I) Malaviya National Institute of Technology, Jaipur (Rajasthan)
 - (II) National Institute of Technology, Durgapur (West Bengal)
 - (III) National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli(Tamil Nadu)
 - (IV) Delhi Technological University (Delhi)
 - (V) National Institute of Technology, Warangal(Telegana)
 - (VI) Cochin University of Science and Technology, Kochi (Kerala)
 - (VII) Anna University, hennai (Tamil Nadu)
 - (VIII) Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology, New Delhi (Delhi)
- Students are advised to visit University/Institute website and do thorough research of course offered, eligibility criteria and general information before applying for admission.
- **Scholarship is awarded only after the High Commission is satisfied that the student intending to study in India has no serious health issues**, has not submitted incomplete/fraudulent documentation or any other such parameters, which may negate the objective of promoting goodwill through these scholarships.
